


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
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RENTAL SUITABILITY CHECKLIST

Ensure the total cost, including rent, utilities (e.g., gas, electricity, waste disposal), and potential extra fees (e.g., realtor, maintenance, internet), fits your budget.
Request recent utility bills from the landlord or agent to understand additional costs.
List essential amenities (e.g., dishwasher, washing machine, furnished or unfurnished) and confirm these are provided.
Ask about the type of heating system, as this affects utility costs.
If possible, speak to previous tenants about their experience with the rental and landlord.
Compare similar rentals in the area to avoid overpaying.



ESSENTIAL RENTAL FEATURES







Confirm the **rental term** aligns with your needs (check start and end dates in the contract).

Document any **extra agreements**in the contract (e.g., holiday
payment terms, responsibilities for
repairs).

Rent and utility costs typically ranges from 70:30 to 60:40, depending on the season; ask for previous bills to estimate expenses.

Ensure the agreed rent and utilities (if "all-inclusive" is offered) are clearly stated in the agreement.

Make all payments by **bank transfer** for security and avoid cash or untraceable transactions.

Discuss **property tax** responsibilities; these are often negotiable between tenant and landlord.


Clarify maintenance cost responsibilities (e.g., repairs to meters, light bulbs).

Understand the **building's age** and **type**, as it impacts utility and maintenance expenses.

Ensure all **tenants are listed** in the contract if it's a shared rental.



LEASE AGREEMENT ESSENTIALS

There are three types of leases. Always keep a signed copy of the lease (digital or physical).







Fixed-Term Lease

Offers a set term, usually one year, with fixed terms for rent and rules.

Month-to-Month Lease

Continues until either party ends the agreement.

One-Way Lease

Uncommon; may involve fees if the tenant leaves early.

Double-check all details (name, address, costs, policies) for accuracy.
Look for any charges or penalties (e.g., for late payments, pet fees, cleaning).
Confirm rules on subletting, guests, and other restrictions.
Understand the conditions and refundability of the security deposit.
Review the escape clause and notice period requirements.
Check if the contract falls under Residential Tenancy Law or Arbitration (https://likumi.lv/ta/en/en/id/322216 in English).

APARTMENT INSURANCE



Insurance type

Many rentals have basic insurance covering the structure only; personal belongings are usually not covered.

Renter's Insurance:

Covers belongings in case of fire, theft, or damage.

Liability Coverage:

Covers damage caused by tenant negligence (e.g., flooding).

Providers

Insurance providers include Swedbank, Balcia Insurance, Ergo, among others.

AVOIDING RENTAL FRAUD



Use trusted rental sites

- Arco Real Estate (broker fee may apply)

- Use caution with ss.lv and Facebook groups.
- Explore university student housing options.

See yourself

Always view the apartment in person and meet the landlord.

Payments

Avoid unorthodox payment methods; pay only after signing a contract, using traceable payment methods.

WHEN MOVING-IN

- Inspect and document any pre-existing damages with photos, including date and time stamps.
- Report any issues to the landlord in writing to avoid disputes later.

WHEN MOVING-OUT

- Review your **contract's notice period** and any early termination penalties.
- Ensure your notice aligns with the rental period (typically 30 days).
- **Keep proof** of notice delivery (email, receipt, or photo evidence).
- Obtain a copy of any **personal records** to prevent misunderstandings.

IMPORTANT WARNINGS



- Avoid any agreements not documented in writing and ensure you retain a signed copy.
- Do not pay rent or a deposit until the contract is signed and accompanied by an invoice.
- Avoid paying in cash, and don't use untraceable online services or wire transfers.
- **Never sign** a contract until you fully understand its terms and have all necessary information.
- Keep original proof of payment with you at all times.



RIGA NEIGHBOURHOOD GUIDE

Vecriga (1 - Green Zone)

Very safe area with excellent public transport, though rental prices are high.

Centra Rajons (2 - Orange Zone)

Also very safe and central, with great transport options; however, still on the pricier side.

Avoti (3 - Blue Zone)

Safe and central with good public connections; generally an expensive area.

Teika (4 – Pink Zone)

Safe and relatively central with good transport links; more affordable than central zones.

Zemgale/Agenskalns (5 - Purple Zone)

Safe and centrally located with good public transport; affordable rent.

Imanta (6 - Yellow Zone)

Safe but farther from the city center, well-connected by transport, and affordable.

Latgale District (7 - Red Zone)

Less safe and less central with limited transport options, but rent is affordable.





































ACCOMMODATION OPTIONS


WELCOME TOJELGAVA
